Antonio Reeves showcased the ability to be a scorer at all 3 levels, finishing at the rim off cuts and transition lays, hitting a catch and shoot 3, and find his shot off the dribble around the midrange. He did display the willingness to get out and run in transition as he does so early in the game for a lay and then again but this time, he will draw a foul on the lay attempt. Antonio Reeves will have 18 points on 7/12 shooting for the field and 1/3 from the perimeter. As far as his playmaking ability, Reeves didn't show much regarding that. Reeves didn't force shots be he did look for a shot every chance he got.

Reeves defense will be there at times in this game. Reeves does show the ability to play off ball defense and rebound in this game as he comes away with 5 rebounds. Reeves will struggle at times in this game with on ball defense, getting beat off the dribble a few times in this one. Reeves would have 1 steal in this game, but I just feel like an improvement area for Reeves has to be his on-ball defense.

While Antonio Reeves displayed his ability as a scorer at 3 levels, His shots from 3pt line was not as accurate as he went 1/3 from the perimeter. Also, his playmaking was not displayed is this game, however Antonio did show the mentality of a scorer this game. I noticed that Antonio shots can tend to be tough look or quick looks. An improve area would be being patience and taking great looks rather than any look he gets.
