Offensively, Devin struggled to find a consistent rhythm. He managed to hit a pull-up transition three-pointer and successfully split PnR coverage to get to the rim, finishing high above the big defender. Another notable play was his explosive drive past his defender at the top of the key in early offense, leading to a high finish at the rim. Although his scoring was limited, Carter showed his playmaking abilities by setting up teammates on drive-and-kick and drive-and-drop assists. A highlight was his one-handed shovel pass off the dribble, where he drew two defenders on the right wing and found the big man alone in the lane.

Defensively, he was very impressive, especially on the glass. He aggressively pursued rebounds, going up to get the ball out of the air rather than waiting for it to come to him. His ability to chase down long boards and secure rebounds was notable. Once he grabbed the defensive rebound, Carter was quick to push the ball in transition, often before the defense could set up, showcasing his ability to turn defense into offense effectively.

He demonstrated flashes of offensive potential with his ability to knock down a transition three, split PnR coverage, and finish at the rim. His playmaking skills were evident as he set up teammates with drive-and-kick and drive-and-drop assists, along with a standout shovel pass. Carter's rebounding ability and quick transition play were standout aspects of his game.
