

## Jaylon Tyson vs UCLA - 01-06-24 FILM

Jaylon Tyson will showcase his ability to create off the dribble, finding teammates and finishing around the rim well. Both of Jaylon's assist will be off drives from the right wing and kicking the ball out to the corner for a 3pt shot. He will bring the ball up a lot in this game. When he doesn't have the ball, he will roam around the perimeter and makes cuts to the basket. Jaylon will have 3 dunks off back door cuts in this game. Showing his ability to play off what the defense is giving him and move without the ball he realized they were face guarding him and would take advantage with back door cuts. Jaylon will have a play that stood out around the 14:59 mark in the second half as he catches the ball on the right wing with the shot clock running low. Drives right and splits 2 defenders as he finishes with a lay at the rim. Showing his ability to stay calm and get to a spot for a good look with time going down.

Jaylon Tyson will be solid defensively in this one. He will have a play that stood out around the 8:49 mark in the second half as he will be sitting in help position and sees the big man leave his feet to make a pass and gets in the passing lane for the steal. Jaylon will also show active hands getting rebounds and deflecting a pass while denying his man the ball on defense. He will tend to over help at times and lose sight of his man, could've be costly if his match up understood to cut at those times.

While Jaylon Tyson exhibited the ability to score off the dribble and create. He will have 3 TOs in this game. With one coming off a charge call and another being a careless pass. I noticed that Jaylon will often attack the rim out of control and will sometimes get stuck forcing him to find a pass out. He will however clean up those small mistakes in the second half. As he will end the game with 22 points on 9/12 shooting from the field and 2/3 from the perimeter. 17 of those 22 points will come in the second half as he just seems to find his rhythm and keeps his team on top in this one.
