

Michael DeVoe (Film: January 30, 2020, vs Florida State)

DeVoe got off to an extremely slow start this game offensively. He scored his first points with 7:34 left in the first on a pair of free throws and ended the half with only five points on 1-5 shooting. Was still active in the game by securing 3 rebounds and 2 assist in a low scoring half for the Yellow Jacket guard.

DeVoe was far more active in the second half. Started the half by knocking down two three-point shots at 16:45 and 13:13 respectively. Most impressively, DeVoe was active on the glass against a larger Florida State pulling in five rebounds in the 2nd. Showcased a great nose for the ball and hustle by securing three offensive rebounds helped DeVoe get to the free throw line twice and find and open teammate for an assist.

This game highlighted potential weaknesses for DeVoe at the professional level, particularly when facing physical, long defenses. DeVoe only converted one field goal attempt that did not come from three as he struggled converting his midrange and layup attempts. But, despite this he still shot 43% from three and proved he could contribute when his shot is not falling by leading all teams in rebounds and posting the second most assist.
