Antonio Reeves showcased his ability to score of the dribble, knock down perimeter shots, and make plays for others. Antonio will have a play around the 12:58 mark in the second half as the ball swings around the perimeter. Reeves get the ball on the left wing and immediately attacks the close out defender going baseline and steps through making a floater at the rim. This play is just an example of the type of crafty game Antonio had offensively. He was able to beat guys off the dribble and get to his spots. Antonio also did well at drawing foul on attacks to the rim. He hasn't settled for 3s in this game, has also done well attacking and running in transition.

Defensively, Antonio Reeves was solid on this end. He didn't show anything special or have any plays that will stand out. However, he also didn't have any defensive mistakes that would stand out. He will end the game with 4 rebounds but didn't record a steal or a block. He did well in the gaps and on ball pressure as well.

While Antonio Reeves exhibited the ability to make plays for others, he will also have a couple careless turnovers. He will attempt to throw a lob pass in transition that will result in a TO and then he would have another bad pass in transition that would become a TO. At moments Antonio will look to play fast and really try to push the tempo. Sometimes this will end with a turnover, or a miss shot attempt and other times it will end great for him. A play comes to mind in the first half as he gets the rebound and pushes up the court in transition, euro steps for a right hand lay. Antonio Reeves will end the game with 27 points and 3 assist on 8/12 shooting from the field and 2/5 from 3pt. Also, will go 9/9 from the free throw line.
