He was highly active on the offensive glass, quickly getting off the ground to capitalize on second-chance opportunities. This skill led to both putback dunks and layups, demonstrating his ability to convert rebounds into points effectively. He also showcased finesse around the rim with a floater off the glass, highlighting his versatility in scoring from different areas on the court. His combination of athleticism and improved touch around the basket was impressive. Additionally, he proved capable of running the floor well in transition, catching the ball on the move, and converting efficiently.

He exhibited strong shot-blocking abilities, consistently altering shots with his impressive timing. His explosive second jump allowed him to recover quickly for secondary shot challenges, making him a formidable presence in the paint. He also demonstrated the ability to guard multiple positions, moving his feet well on the perimeter to defend guards and wings while using his length and strength to compete on the interior. His activity on both the offensive and defensive glass further underscores his effectiveness in securing rebounds and providing his team with additional possessions.

While he has shown the potential to impact the game on both ends of the floor, there are areas for improvement. Offensively, he demonstrated range by stepping out to hit three-pointers, but his shooting consistency needs work to become a more reliable outside threat. Defensively, he must improve his discipline, as he tends to fall for pump fakes. Additionally, his feel as a passer and ball handler could be enhanced, although he did showcase the ability to drive in a straight line. Focusing on these areas will help him become a more complete player.
