

Drew Pember vs Michigan 11/7/23.

Pember started the game off slow but was still affective on both ends of the floor. He has a height advantage which helped on offense when attacking to the basket. He attacked the basket from the top of the key and drew another player, then dumping it off to his teammate on the other block. He has a good spin move. When on offense he spun off his defender at the top of the key and rolled to the basket, catching the ball and being patient and drawing a foul for two free-throws. On the defensive end he was aware and attached to his person. He had a good close out to the corner wing for the shooter to miss the 3pt shot. His length was his advantage at some points in the game. One play that was good was a rebound, full court dribble full speed, with a good up and under. They called a travel, but it was a good move and could've been affective. He came out the 1<sup>st</sup> half for a couple minutes with 4 pts and 2 fouls. He came back in and had a good pump fake and drive to basket. But after that play he was out again because he picked up his 3<sup>rd</sup> foul.

2<sup>nd</sup> half was where his strengths showed the most. He did pick up his 4<sup>th</sup> foul in the beginning of the 2<sup>nd</sup> half and was out for a few minutes. When he got back in, he showed multiple areas of strengths on the defensive and offensive end. On the offensive end he had a nice post move to the basket towards the middle and while going up draws the foul. He made 2 free-throws after this play. On the offensive end again, he attacked the basket from the top of the key, spin move to middle drawing another foul for 2 free-throws: making both. Another play that showed his athletic ability was a good strong rebound, full court dribble, spin move, and a fade away shot drawing another foul, with 2 free-throws to follow. He has good moves and drawing fouls when going to the basket and shooting.

He also has a good 3pt shot. He had a transition 3pt on the wing. There was also another play where he caught the ball, pump fake and drew a foul for 2 free-throws. His athletic ability was very interesting. There was a play in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half where he caught the ball, pump fake, drove to the basket on the left side. He missed the initial shot but got his own rebound to tip it back in. He had another catch and shoot 3 at the top of the key. The last play that caught my eye before he got out for the rest of the game was him on the free-throw line and bounce pass to teammate.

His skillset is there I just couldn't see him at his full potential because of foul trouble. But his length and ability to be down low and on the wing could be very effective. He has a good drive to the basket but also a good 3pt shot. He can make free-throws as well and draw fouls when attacking the basket.
