

Reed Sheppard vs KU 11/14/23 – In Person

Clean, repeatable jump shot form. He shoots the same shot every time. Played at his own pace, and showed good IQ to be in the right positions on both side of the ball.

Sheppard showcased the ability to make jumpshots from behind the arc. He was not counted on much as a ballhandler, but made the right decisions with the ball in his hands. He made three threes, two from the R wing and one from the L corner. One play in particular with 8:40 left in the second half, he pulled up from the R wing and drilled the deep three with no hesitation once his defender went under the screen.

Sheppard displayed good team defensive principles as well as quick hands. He had 4 steals and constantly got his hands on the ball defensively.

Overall, Sheppard made the right play with the ball in his hands seemingly every time he had it (outside of the last shot of the game). While he also played sound defense.
