## Terrance Shannon - vs Marquette 11/14/23

On the offensive end, Terrance Shannon didn't have his best performance against Marquette while he struggled from the field making 6-16 shots. He was a streaky shooter taking the majority of contested shots on the catch and off the dribble. He likes to crossover from left to right when creating a jumper for himself (main move). Airballed two shots crying to shoot over players in isolation moment. It was hard for him to take care of the ball by making careless passes in traffic. Turnover came from forcing passing in P&R actions and throwing cross-court passes while a defender is on him. He can find players when penetrating the lanes because of his speed and athleticism which is important for the team spacing and scoring. He did do a good job slashing and attacking the rim when coming downhill in transition or when cutting. He got to the line 3 times making all of his free throws. Overall if he was more responsible with the ball in his hands, the game could have gone better for him. He still needs to show he can be a consistent shooter from the court and show that he can be trusted to make the right decision with the ball when creating for himself and others. On the defensive end, he had a solid performance creating 3 turnovers with 1 block and 2 steals. Use his athleticism and commitment to perform a chase-down block earlier in the game. He was guarding the wing for most of the time. He did a good job staying connected to the players when getting hit by off ball screen and doing so allowed him to get a steal and didn't allow the ball to move around freely.
