

## Johnny Furphy (Cincinnati at Kansas 1/23/24) – Film

Johnny demonstrated effectiveness in transition, leveraging his speed to fill the lanes and capitalize on opportunities at the rim. His activity on the offensive glass was notable, consistently securing second-chance opportunities and providing valuable extra possessions for his team. Moreover, he showcased proficiency in catch-and-shoot situations, converting 3-4 attempts from beyond the arc. However, his decision-making proved to be a point of concern, as evidenced by a misguided post entry pass and errant attempts at backdoor cuts, resulting in turnovers.

Defensively, Johnny displayed promise as an active defender, particularly on the perimeter where he effectively moved his feet to contest shots. His ability to disrupt passing lanes was evident, as he deflected a couple of passes as well. Additionally, he was highly active on the defensive glass, pulling down eight rebounds on that end of the court, indicating his commitment to complete defensive possessions.

While Johnny excelled in transition offense and shooting off the catch from beyond the arc, addressing areas such as decision-making and passing accuracy will be crucial for minimizing turnovers and maximizing offensive efficiency. Moreover, enhancing his defensive consistency and overall awareness will contribute significantly to his development into a more well-rounded player.
